



2019 Sawdust Distribution & Removal Tender Specifications

General Information: The Gympie District Show Society Inc. (GDSS) is a non-profit community-based organisation, which organises the Gympie District Show. Last year over 38,000 people passed through our gates. This year marks our 131st Show and will be a 3-day event being held on Thursday 16th, Friday 17th and Saturday 18th May 2019.

REQUIREMENTS

Target

The GDSS requires the services of licensed bobcat / truck operators to move sawdust in and out of various animal sections during the Show.

All contractors tendering **MUST** be licensed and have all necessary Insurances required by Law.

Note the bulk supply of clean sawdust and removal of sawdust at the end of the Show is a separate Tender.

Contractor

- The contractor is to supply the GDSS with the name and mobile telephone number of their onsite person in charge.
- The contractor will ensure that all staff are provided with a copy of the Gympie Show Information Guide.
- Before Show on May 10th but after 12PM:
 - Sawdust to be moved into stalls from the delivery points on the attached site plan as directed by the Chief Steward of the Section or the Site Supervisor.
- During Show May 16th to 18th:
 - Sawdust to be removed from stalls and other areas and new sawdust moved in as directed by the Chief Steward of the Section or the Site Supervisor prior to 6:30am daily.
- After Show and on May 19th.
 - All sawdust to be removed from stalls and other areas and stockpiled at the original delivery points unless directed otherwise by the Site Supervisor.
 - Note some stable holder may desire to retain the used sawdust in their stall at the end of Show. This impacts up to a maximum of 110 cubic meters of sawdust in the stables. Details of the amount of sawdust to stay in place will be provided by the Site Supervisor.
- Based on the above a separate price is required for the removal of sawdust from the stable area.
- Any variations to the above including any associated costs will be negotiated with the Show Secretary.

The GDSS will provide details of the sawdust that needs to stay in the stables by Saturday 18th May.

- ❖ Upon successful provision of the services being provided (as above) to the GDSS, the GDSS will pay the fee as tendered to the contractor.
- ❖ Payment of the fee by the GDSS will be made within 28 days of receipt of a complying tax invoice from the contractor.
- ❖ The contractor will provide the GDSS with a complying tax invoice by Friday the 31st May 2019
