- 1. OFFICE ENTRIES CLOSE 6:30PM Wednesday 14th MAY 2025
- 2. NO ONLINE ENTRIES
- 3. GST will apply if an Exhibitor enters an Exhibit as a Business entity, the Exhibitor has an ABN, and the Exhibitor is REGISTERED for GST.
  - Where GST applies, the Association will pay the prize money quoted in this Schedule plus 10% GST. The Gympie Show Society will issue a recipient created tax invoice for prize money paid.
- 4. Please provide your ABN and GST registration details on entry form if you are entering as a business entity.
- 5. REMEMBER that all entries must be supplied with attached entry forms (available online and from the office). Entries will not be accepted without this form.

#### **EXHIBIT DELIVERY AND COLLECTION**

- 1. Exhibits are to be delivered to the Show Pavilion on the following days and times:
  - a. Tuesday 13th May between 2pm and 4pm
  - b. Wednesday 14<sup>th</sup> May between 2pm and 6.30pm
- 2. Exhibits may be collected from the Show Pavilion on the following days and times:
  - a. Saturday 17th May between 4pm and 6pm
  - b. Sunday 18th May between 8am and 9am
- 3. Exhibits not collected on the above dates may be collected from the Show Office between 10am and 2pm, Tuesday to Friday until the 23rd May.
- 4. Exhibits not collected by 4pm Friday 23rd May shall be disposed of by the Gympie District Show Society Inc.

#### **JUDGING**

- 1. Judging commences at 7am on Thursday 15<sup>th</sup> May.
- 2. It is the Exhibitor's responsibility to record your entry in the correct class. If in doubt, ask a Steward.
- 3. Points will, on all occasions, be left in the hands of the Judge.
- 4. If an Exhibitor exhibits in a name other than his or her own name and such exhibits will be awarded prizes (where merited) and points awarded according to the name on the exhibit, i.e. where prizes are awarded on a special points system and a person exhibits in more than one name, they shall, for the purpose of awarding points, be two separate persons.

#### PRIZE MONEY COLLECTION

1. Prize Money will be paid on Saturday 17th May between 4pm to 6pm and Sunday 8am to 9am.

#### **GENERAL RULES**

- 1. No diseased or pest infected plant will be accepted.
- 2. Only authorised Stewards allowed in Judging area (if in doubt, check with a Steward).
- 3. Exhibits in general classes cannot form part of a collection.
- 4. Should any dispute arise for which no specified rule is laid down, the matter in dispute shall be referred to the Head Steward whose decision shall be final.
- 5. BOTTLES ARE PROVIDED FOR CUT FLOWERS.
- 6. Entries are accepted entirely at owners' risk. The Society, its members and volunteers will not be liable for any loss or damage to exhibits or any property whatsoever and however such damage or loss occurs. All reasonable care is taken always.
- 7. A single **EXHIBIT** may be entered into a **SINGLE CLASS ONLY.**
